How can you help?

If your child is unable to attend school for any reason you should let the school know.

Notify the school first thing in the morning when your child is going to be absent.

Let the school know the likely date of return and keep them informed if the date changes.

Important

The school must be kept fully informed of any change to the following:

- home telephone number
- mobile number
- emergency contact details

What the school will do?

Where no notification of absence has been received the school will make all reasonable attempts to contact:

- parent/carer
- emergency contact

Where the school has been unable to make contact the Head Teacher will send a letter to the parent/carer asking them to get in touch.

In certain circumstances the school may seek advice from other agencies.
