

Pupil Equity Funding (PEF)

As shared with you previously and discussed at Parent Council meetings, Crosshouse Primary is receiving additional funding from the Scottish Government in order to help 'close the poverty related attainment gap'. After consultation with parents/carers, pupils and staff last year we decided to spend our additional funding on the following:

- Appointment of secondary PE teacher (Mrs Doig)
- Provide additional time for class teachers to work with small groups of children on targeted interventions.
- Purchase literacy and numeracy resources to assist teachers with targeted interventions.
- Increase extra curricular club provision with no cost to families.
- Staff training in Literacy, Numeracy and Health & Wellbeing
- Increase pupil participation and engagement in the use of digital technologies. Purchase IPads & Chrome Books.

We continually monitor and assess the impact of our Pupil Equity Fund interventions and we will be producing a detailed report before the end of the school year. We will be asking for your opinion on the impact of our PEF spend this year and we will be seeking your views on what our priorities should be for next year.
