Parent Council Meeting

Welcome and Apologies

Review of Outstanding Actions & Previous Minutes

Headteacher Report

On year 3 of the 3-year plan on the school improvement plan

Inspections – school does a pre-evaluation and the inspectors verifies it. The findings are then captured in the report accordingly

For this year the school will be concentrating on just writing improvement as part of the school improvement plan. That is a decrease from about 7/8 priorities from last year.

The school is using guidance from Teaching Sprints approach for the 'Improving our Writing' initiative.

Maintenance agenda concentrates on all the area that the school has been working on previously

The school is aiming to gain several awards this year with there on-going improvement initiatives

How PCC members can get involved was presented to such as helping around the school and committees.

HMIe Inspection

The school was inspected in April 2025 and the report came out on the 9th of September 2025. It is a great report the school has received, and the school should be very proud for the exceptional compliments received.

The next steps – there will be publicity on the report

Communication with wider parent forum including publication of Agenda and minutes of PCC Meetings.

Secretarial role – it is important to ensure that the agenda is out prior to the parent forum and to PCC members. Afterwards the minutes should be published to all PCC members, agreed and published on the website.

If the role is not fulfilled, then the PCC constitution will need to be amended accordingly. New members that joined for the first time this month

It is important to ensure that the council members are notified and invited to all meetings

School Fund Committee

The money allocated to the school is the money given to the school from the parent and fundraising committee. The committee will be involved in deciding how the money from this fund is to be spend. The main purpose is for audit trail as part of the finance procedure. The school need to have a fund committee that will occur three times a year. Any spending over five hundred needs approval, however small spending such as taxi fare do not

Ideal members would be the treasures from parent and fundraising committee. Four spaces need to be filled and members will need to be voted on.

Car Parking

It is getting better, however still being a problem.

After school clubs

It is impossible to have an afterschool club for each stage, due to accommodation for the variety of clubs.

Council events sports such as football, athletics, netball and dance get priority to allow the school to get involved in it. These clubs allow the kids to get involved sporting where they represent the school.

Staffing allocation and training is a further aspect that should be considered, and teachers do this voluntary.
