Items which are not part of our uniform:

✗ Leggings ✗ Hooded jumpers or zippers. ✗ Branded clothing including branded leggings, joggers and shorts. ✗ Inappropriate footwear. ✗ Clothing carrying advertising, particularly tobacco or alcohol. ✗ Clothing which can be deemed unsuitable in terms of health and safety grounds such as combat style clothing, dangling earrings, loose fitting clothes, particularly in practical lessons. ✗ Football tops/colours. ✗ Clothing causing offense such as anti-religious symbolism or political slogans
